Fantastic overnight stays in the Europa-Park hotels

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Experience adventure, leave everyday worries behind: After an exciting day in the 17 european themed areas of Germany's largest theme park, or an exciting expedition to the Rulantica water world, the six 4* (superior) themed hotels offer visitors the perfect mix of further adventures and soothing relaxation. With an overnight stay in one of the park's own themed hotels, your stay in Rust in southern Baden will become an unforgettable short holiday.

If you want to escape from everyday life, you are in good hands at the Europa-Park Hotel Resort. The 4* hotels 'El Andaluz' and 'Castillo Alcazar' along with the 4* superior hotels 'Colosseo', 'Santa Isabel', 'Bell Rock' and 'Krønasår' offer more than just culinary perfection to suit everyone's tastes. In the detailed ambience,

visitors can immerse themselves in wildly romantic castle life, enjoy a sort of 'la Dolce Vita', follow in the footsteps of the Pilgrims fathers, or go on a tour of discovery in the museum hotel. Located in the scenic border triangle region, the Europa-Park Hotel Resort is not only the perfect starting point for a visit to the

world's best amusement park and the Rulantica water world, but also for trips to the attractive surrounding area.

Nordic mythology: The 4* superior hotel 'Krønasår', which opened in 2019, is a very special kind of natural history museum. The Scandinavian-styled themed hotel offers an unforgettable stay all year round, especially for curious explorers. In 276 lovingly themed rooms and 28 suites, guests of all ages can experience a uniquely beautiful 'hygge' time. Since August 2022, visitors have also been able to forget the stress of everyday life in eleven additional suites, the 'Krønasår Boutique Suites', promising an unforgettable time in the luxurious rooms. To make things perfectly optimal, guests can look forward to direct access to the new 160 square meter infinity pool via the ground floor. Furthermore, the "Krønasår Boutique Suites" offer a separate check-in, ensuring so that your holiday is relaxed from the very start. Seven of the eleven suites take guests to the far north. The other four are furnished in a futuristic style based on the new culinary experience 'Eatrenalin', which is located in the immediate vicinity of the eleven suites. The premises are equipped with exclusive amenities, such as a private sauna or a private steam room.

The 4* superior hotel also leaves nothing to be desired in terms of cuisine: In the 'Bubba Svens' restaurant, which resembles an old boathouse, there is a traditional fish box with prawns, fried plaice and salmon – delicacies that are sure to get the heart of every seafarer racing. Traditional meets modern in the fine-dining restaurant 'Tre Krøner', where guests have the choice between cleverly prepared meat and fish dishes, traditional braised dishes and the many delicacies of the seasonal and down-to-earth 'Nordic Cuisine'. The cosy 'Café Konditori' entices with homemade cakes and patisserie. In the 'Bubba Svens SportsBar' visitors can leave everyday life behind with billiards, darts and table football, as well as reenergising at the ship's bar with cold drinks and

delicious food. Football fans will also get their money's worth here, as all football matches are broadcast live. To round out this varied offer, the 'Bar Erikssøn', which combines Nordic bread specialties with skilful toppings 'à la smørrebrød' and offers an extensive aquavit range. Additionally, 'panoraama - the Rulantica Bar' offers a unique view over the impressive Rulantica water world with a stylish Nordic ambience, bowls filled with colourful salads, avocado, cucumber, mango, ginger and soybean sprouts on airy basmati rice as well as homemade lemonades. In the Hygge sauna bar, found in the exclusive relaxation and sauna area 'Hyggedal', the same refreshing delicacies are available - so get in your bikini and swimming trunks and head to the water world!

Guests of the hotel can enjoy direct access to Rulantica. With a valid ticket, hotel guests can use the entire water world one hour before regular opening hours. Bell Rock – 4* superior hotel

Fantastic nights in the lighthouse: The red and white lighthouse, symbol of the 4* superior hotel 'Bell Rock', proudly and gracefully guides travellers to safe holiday haven. The New England style of the hotel promises an expedition to an early America, with rooms filled with light, maritime accessories, high-quality antiques and lavish handmade items. Three restaurants offer a diverse selection of culinary delights: The high-quality 'Harborside' buffet restaurant with integrated front cooking area and open grills, the service restaurant 'Captain's Finest' and the 2* restaurant 'Ammolite - The Lighthouse Restaurant' in the lighthouse, with a visible kitchen area, are sure to get hearts racing. Just two years after it opened in 2012, the 'Ammolite' was awarded 2 Michelin stars and 16 Gault Millau points. In 2020, chef de cuisine Peter Hagen-Wiest and his team even managed to achieve 18 Gault Millau points for the first time. The 'Ammolite - The Lighthouse Restaurant' is the only 2* restaurant in an amusement park in the world. The café-bar 'Spirit of St. Louis' with an outdoor terrace rounds off this extensive gastronomic offer.

Hotel guests who feel like exercising after enjoying the culinary delights can use the 'New England' fitness and spa area. In the 'Boston Red Sox' fitness club, endurance athletes and fans of fitness classes can get their money's worth from the age of 16: In addition to a 400-square-metre fitness room with the latest equipment, there are two training rooms for effective courses. Furthermore, hotel guests can make use of the diverse range of courses offered by the Europa-Park Talent Academy. Afterwards, there are a variety of options for relaxation in the 'Blue Lagoon' sauna area. In the 'Bell Rock' Wellness & Spa, a soothing massage pampers body and soul.

La dolce vita: The Italian 4* superior hotel 'Colosseo', which is open to guests all year round, exudes an exhilarating sense of joie de vivre. Cafés invite you to linger and relax in the shade of large parasols and watch the hustle and bustle on the piazza. If you look along the facades, which are designed in a way that is typical of the country, your eyes may catch the balcony of the stylishly-furnished 'Colosseo' bar on the fifth floor. In addition to restaurants, the 4* superior hotel features Italian restaurants 'Antica Roma', 'Medici' and the 'Pizzeria La Romantica' as well as meeting rooms such as the 'Aqua Romana' inside the Colosseum arches. A large outdoor pool (with indoor entry), a sauna complex and the luxurious wellness and spa area offer unbridled relaxation just like in the time of Caesar. Imperial luxury waits in the four lavishly decorated VIP suites within the curves of the Colosseum. One spectacular highlight is the VIP Presidential Suite 'Roma – Bella Vista'. Up to eight guests can enjoy a stylish stay in the approximately 400 m² luxury suite and take advantage of an exclusive VIP service.

A look behind the monastery walls: The 4* Superior Hotel 'Santa Isabel' is modelled after a Portuguese monastery. It has its own chapel, two conference rooms on the ground floor and a monastery cellar that can be booked for celebrations in an extraordinary atmosphere. In the 'Sala Santa Isabel'

an exclusive evening buffet menu with traditional specialties from the lava stone grill awaits hungry guests. Furthermore, hotel guests can make use of the diverse range of courses offered by the Europa-Park Talent Academy. Afterwards, there are a variety of options for relaxation in the 'Blue Lagoon' sauna area.

Welcome to the Middle Ages: Roughly hewn stone meets graceful furniture and lovely decorations on the walls of the cosy rooms and extravagant and uniquely furnished suites. The 4* hotel 'Castillo Alcazar' excels with an appealing contrast between wildly romantic castle living and state-of-the-art interiors. In the Castillo buffet restaurant, meat lovers in particular can get their money's worth: Rodizio-style, large rotisserie skewers are prepared on the open grill and served at the table. There is also a rich buffet with warm specialty dishes and homemade salads. Romantics are sure to find happiness in the Buena Vista Club bar up on the ninth floor, as the sunset bathes Europa-Park in golden colour. Orient meets Occident: Orient meets Occident as comfortable corner sofas allow guests to lean back into splendid brocade like kings and queens. The youngest visitors don't miss out either, as they can let off steam in the cool water at the 'Pueblo del Agua' water playground.

Mediterranean elegance: The first hotel 'El Andaluz' to open in a German amusement park has individually designed, air-conditioned rooms that are equipped with comfortable box-spring beds and show that tradition and modernity are not contradictory. A lush palm garden forms the heart of the Spanish Finca-style complex. The enchanting variety of scents that surround the hotel pool are a delight to the senses. The rooms and suites are set up to accommodate families, carrying guests away to their very own southern Spanish summer villa with Mediterranean elegance. In the evening, guests can be enthralled by Moorish water features and the sounds of flamenco.

With the Europa-Park Hotel App, guests can not only directly book rooms, but also wellness treatments, as well as make table reservations. In addition, the

application provides up-to-date information on the hotel program as well as events in Europa-Park and the Rulantica water adventure world. The integrated notification centre also notifies users that their desired room is ready or their reservation in a restaurant is imminent. Other features, such as the personalised timeline and EP express train radar, allow guests to tailor their stay to suit their needs. At the end of an unforgettable visit there is even the opportunity to check out digitally via the App. In addition, users can see when the next hotel resort shuttle is leaving.

No matter which of the six park-owned hotels the guests are staying in, a comfortable Hotel Resort shuttle runs every 15 to 30 minutes, morning to night, and conveniently connects the Europa-Park hotels with each other. It takes visitors to the Europa-Park hotel entrance, to the water world, to YULLBE and, after an exciting day, back to the themed hotel.

Experience outdoor adventure at the 'Camp Resort' and spend wild romantic holidays around the roaring campfire. Specially designed for groups and school classes, real tipi tents, covered wagons and log cabins await offering plenty of room. Guests can swim in the nearby natural lake and grill sausages on the campfire in the evening. And for those who don't want to cook their own food, the 210-seat Silver Lake Saloon offers hearty Texas burgers, Western steaks and spare ribs. Those who prefer to spend the night in their own four walls will find Europa-Park Camping right next door, with pitches for mobile homes and caravans, as well as plenty of places to sleep comfortably in your own tent.
