Guests can enjoy mini golf at Gold Rush Golf and relax around crackling campfires, creating a Western atmosphere from morning until night. There's also plenty of action on offer from YULLBE GO in its new location, where visitors can experience state-of-the-art virtual reality in the heart of the Wild West.
